Our production is seeking a permit to film in your area. Please see detailed information about the shoot listed below:

- **Where:** Filming will take place at 505 Central Ave, The Main Library at 501 Copper Ave, and the alley behind the Kimo at 421 Central Ave.
- **When:** Filming will take place on 10/31/2017 at 4pm through 11/1/2017 at 7am.
- **Night filming:** This episode will film on 10/31/2017 at 4pm till 11/1/2017 at 7am. If production lights or sound are of concern please contact anyone listed below.
- **Work trucks:** Trucks will be parked on the south side of Copper Ave between 4th St and 5th St. Additional trucks will be parked on the east and west sides of 5th St between Copper Ave and Central Ave.
- **Basecamp:** Basecamp will be located at 1100 2nd St NW.
- **Parking:** No parking signs will be in place on the south side of Copper Ave between 4th St and 5th St. Additional no parking signs will be in place on the east and west sides of 5th St between Copper Ave and Central Ave.
- **Street closure:** The alley behind the Kimo at 421 Central Ave will be closed between 4th St and 5th St. During filming residents/businesses will have complete access to their property but may experience brief delays.
- **Scene specifics:** There will be live animals in play at our 505 Central Ave set. No other extraordinary circumstances.
- **Scene Description:** The characters escape from a locked basement, while another finds a foreboding message at the library.
- **Equipment Placement:** Generators, lights, etc. will be in play on our sets. One light is to be placed on the 3rd floor of the parking garage at Copper and 5th.
